The Village of Suamico seeks a dynamic and experienced municipal finance professional to join its Department Head team:

- This highly responsible position provides professional services to the Village Board and Village Administrator.
- The Finance Director is accountable for prudent management, accounting, and clear reporting of the Village's financial resources in accordance with State Statutes and Village ordinances.
- Responsible for maintaining and keeping accounting records in accordance with Generally Accepted Accounting Principles (GAAP).
- Serves as Coordinator for Information Technology services and provides oversight of the computer and information systems of the Village in collaboration with the contracted IT services provider.
- The Finance Director reports to the Village Administrator.
- Responsible for the supervision and management of Finance Department employees.
- Serves as Treasurer for the Village
- Prepares departmental and municipal budgets, and assures the proper execution of those budgets through accounting and fiscal controls.
- The starting salary range is \$95K-\$115K (DOQ)

Desirable qualifications for this position includes a bachelor's degree in accounting, finance, business administration, or an appropriate specialized field. A CPA license and certification as a Municipal Treasurer by the Municipal Treasurer's Association of Wisconsin are preferred. The ideal candidate will

have at least three years of experience in a state, county, or municipal government setting or a minimum of three years performing municipal budget audits.

The successful candidate must have experience and knowledge in current principles and practices of municipal finance, the State of Wisconsin property tax levy and collection process, capital improvement financing, and treasurer functions.
